A Community Update — Building Jonesport's Future on the Water



Background

Planning began when Jonesport voted to purchase the Campground property. The concept plan was finished in 2024, with Maine DEP and U.S. Army Corps permits issued in September 2025.

Project Goals

- Preserve as much of the historic Campground as possible — 100+ years of Jonesport culture — while minimizing wetland impact.
- Provide safe, year-round deep-water access for fishers, harvesters, and marine businesses.
- Support the local economy and honor our maritime heritage — a top-three Maine port for live lobster.
- Relieve congestion at the Jonesport Marina, which stays dedicated to recreational use.

Approved by Jonesport voters for the property purchase and matching grant funds

Phase 1

Target opening: spring/summer 2027

- Widen Campground Road for better access for commercial fishers and harvesters.
- Parking for 40–45 truck-and-trailer rigs, plus 20 spaces for standard vehicles.
- A two-lane, 24-foot-wide boat launch with floats on both sides and center.
- Opens to commercial fishers, harvesters, and marine-dependent businesses.

Phase 2

- A raised pier for vehicle use, with hoists, tie-ups, and deep-water access.
- Funding to be secured for the pier, floats, gangways, and berths.
